**South Central Fact Sheet**

**Middlesex**

Ontario Court of Justice

Respondents indicate that child protection matters are not being completed within the proscribed time frames. There are seven criminal judges and they appear to be meeting the workload for the population of 450,000

Superior Court of Justice

Middlesex is outside the acceptable time frame for the completion of family trials and the amount of time set aside for conferences. There are eleven judges for the population.

**Wellington**

Wellington does not meet the acceptable range for the scheduling of conferences. It also reports delays in securing timely dates for long motions. There is one judge for a population of 200,000, assisted by two supernumary judges.

*\*A supernumary judge is a judge who has the option to retire but who chooses to sit half the time of a full time judge.*
